(Wren & Rook)

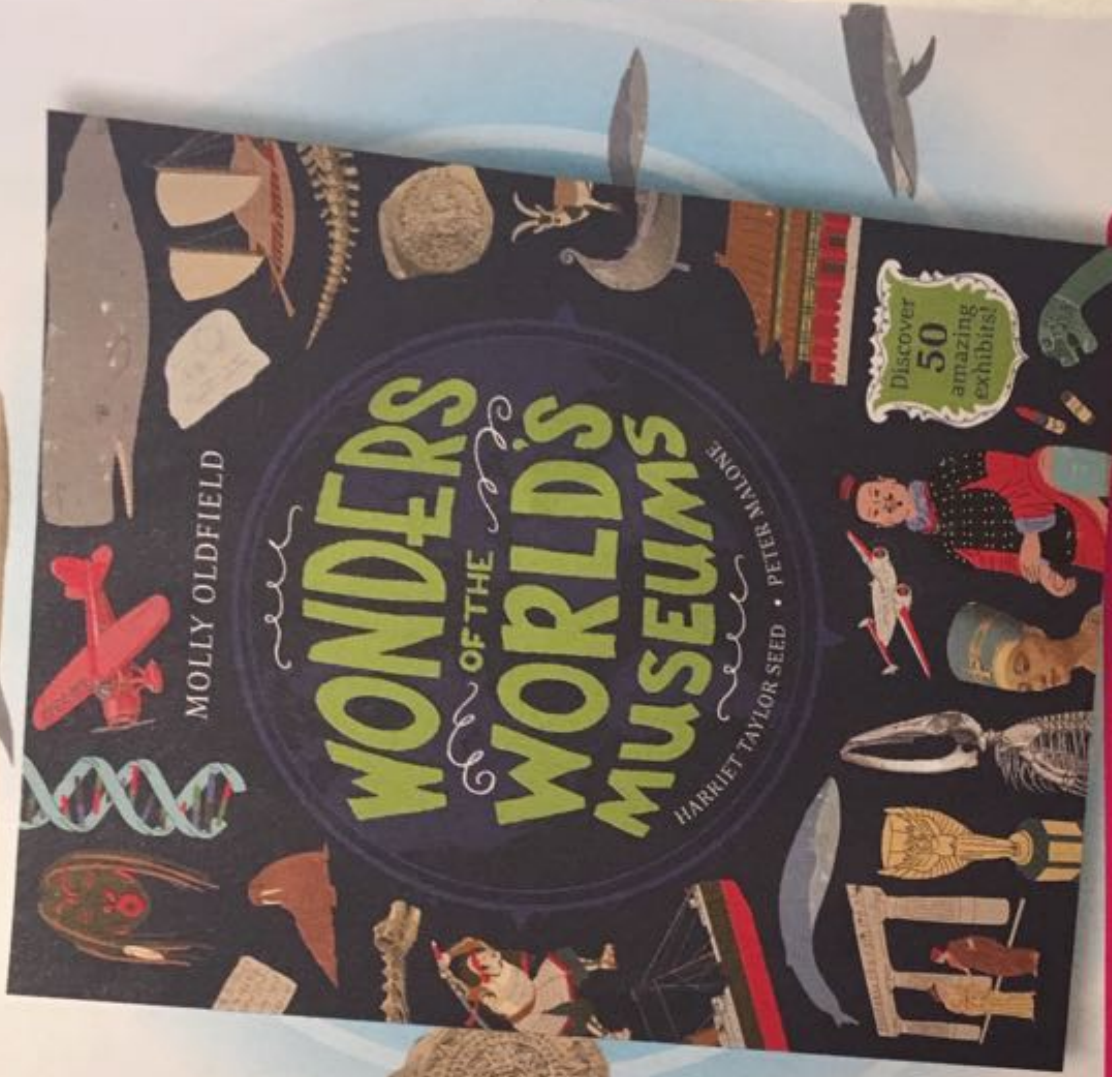
Writer Molly Oldfield shares her love of museums in this illustrated book, which invites you to take a closer look at some of the world's most incredible exhibits.
